#### Cross-Lines' Impact Over the Last Six Months

At Cross-Lines, we believe that access to nutritious food is a fundamental right, not a privilege. Over the past six months, our commitment to fighting food insecurity has remained unwavering, and thanks to the support of our community, we've made a profound impact:

- **6,730 visits to The Community Market**, providing families with fresh and nutritious food.
- \$1,009,500 worth of food distributed to those in need.
- **25,753 meals served in The Kitchen,** ensuring that no one in our community goes hungry.

These numbers reflect more than just statistics—they represent families who can put dinner on the table, seniors who don't have to choose between food and medication, and individuals who know they have a place to turn when times are tough.

# KCK Cold Weather Shelter Recap

As temperatures dropped this winter, the KCK Cold Weather Shelter became a critical lifeline for those experiencing homelessness. Over 32 nights, the shelter provided warmth, safety, and connection to vital resources for 227 unique guests: 74% male and 26% female, including 11 veterans.

Beyond offering emergency shelter, this project served as a bridge to stability. Thanks to our staff's dedicated efforts, 18 individuals have already secured housing, with at least five more expected to resolve their homelessness in the coming weeks.

#### **Key Impact Stats:**

- Total Bed Nights: 1,468
- Nights at Capacity: 22
- Nights Guests Diverted to Hotels: 16
- Nights Open: 32 (25 at 645 Nebraska Ave; 7 at 550 State Ave)

Midseason, Cross-Lines and our partners relocated the shelter to expand capacity and offer 24/7 sheltering options in Wyandotte County. This collaboration ensured no one was left out in the cold, with hotel stays provided during the most extreme weather.

The KCK Cold Weather Shelter is more than just an emergency response. It's a pathway to permanent housing and comprehensive support. Thank you to our partners, volunteers, and supporters for making this lifesaving work possible!


