

#### **Cross-Lines Community Outreach Triumph: Unhoused Resident Finds Hope and a New Home**

Leslie\* and Romeo\*, who were previously living outdoors, now have a place to call home thanks to the dedicated efforts of our community.

An important portion of Cross-Lines' work focuses on the arduous but rewarding process of assisting those experiencing homelessness in securing safe and secure living conditions. This past late-November, in a collaborative effort including Alice of Angel Hearts Rescue, Inc., Vanessa and Rob from Cross-Lines, along with friends Jim, Jennifer, and Josh, we successfully transitioned Leslie and her pet dog, Romeo, from their camp in the woods to a warm and sheltered home, equipped with essential amenities like heat and lights.

Navigating the challenges of finding suitable accommodations for unhoused individuals becomes even more complex when they have beloved animal companions, underscoring the persistent obstacles faced by individuals like Leslie and Romeo in their journey toward stable living conditions. Despite facing cold and rainy conditions that afternoon, the joy of helping secure a new beginning for Leslie and Romeo prevailed. During the relocation process, Romeo, overwhelmed with happiness, energetically ran back and forth, becoming a symbol of the positive impact made by Cross-Lines and our partners.

Leslie's determination and resourcefulness, the dedication and advocacy of our staff, along with the supportive involvement of Angel Hearts, all played crucial roles in facilitating this significant change.

This heartfelt effort emphasizes the importance of our community's support, collaborative initiatives, and the enduring commitment of Cross-Lines Community Outreach to improve the lives of those in need.

## **Program Partner Spotlight**



Health Forward Foundation awards \$125,000 grant to support Housing Stabilization Program Efforts

Cross-Lines was awarded \$125,000.00 in funding from the Health Forward Foundation to increase capacity within our Housing Stabilization programs. Increased capacity will allow Cross-Lines to reach more individuals experiencing homelessness, reduce the individual barriers preventing stable housing, and provide ongoing connection to vital wraparound services that facilitate successful housing once housed.

Cross-Lines plans to hire a peer support worker to assist our Community Resource Navigators within the Cross-Lines Homeless Outreach program and the new Cross-Lines Permanent Housing program, which will become operational in the second half of 2024. The new peer support worker will build relationships with clients, engage with the overarching community, and establish working relationships with community partners. The new Permanent Housing program aims to provide permanent housing for individuals in Wyandotte County experiencing unsheltered homelessness and ensure they are connected to vital supportive services such as document assistance, health & benefits navigation, behavioral health & substance use treatment, food access, and income resources.

Funding from the Health Forward Foundation will ensure that all crucial program components, including all technology needs of the new Permanent Housing program, are in place, guaranteeing a smooth transition to the start of a new Cross-Lines Housing Stabilization program.

### KCK Cold Weather Shelter Provides Warmth for WYCO Unhoused Community

Sleeping on the street is never safe. Sleeping on the street when temperatures fall below freezing can be deadly.

# **Cold Weather Shelter Cont'd**

Welcomed into our shelter each freezing night, individuals receive a warm meal, access to medical services such as COVID-19 testing and vaccinations, and are provided a private space to sleep and store their belongings, safe from brutal winter weather. The shelter ceases operations as planned when the weather warms with the season.

Wyandotte County does not currently have a permanent overnight shelter location. Our unhoused population has nowhere to turn in dire situations like extreme weather, illness, or injury.

Cross-Lines is dedicated to working with the community to find long-term solutions for those experiencing homelessness in Wyandotte County.
