This position also oversees the planning and implementation of marketing directives. The Director of Development works collaboratively with other senior management team members, the Development Committee, the Board of Directors, and the Communications & Development Manager to identify, develop, and communicate fundraising and strategic goals.

#### The key responsibilities include:

- Participate with the Executive Director, Board of Directors, and other management staff in charting the direction of Cross-Lines, assuring accountability to all constituencies.
- Prepare and execute an annual fundraising plan with diverse funding sources. It will include both restricted and unrestricted funds to support the budget of the organization.
- Supervise, support, and collaborate with the Communications & Development Manager.
- Maintain and grow positive donor relationships through meetings, networking, correspondence, etc. that will result in increased funding and participation in sponsorships or attendance at special events
- Develop and implement a fundraising strategy that will support the programs, services and operations of the organization.
- Research and prepare grant proposals in accordance with the funder's giving policies, guidelines, and criteria. Manage grants and grant reports to be certain report deadlines are met.
