Each family receives toys, household items, groceries, and gift cards. We will no longer be providing clothing at the Christmas Store. Instead, each family will receive a gift card to Walmart to purchase the items they need for their family. Our hope is to provide families with joy, as well as the dignity and respect of choosing and gifting brand new presents to their families. CrossLines also gives McDonalds gift cards to people experiencing homelessness.

Cross-Lines is collecting toys and gift cards to Walmart and McDonalds. Monetary donations are also gladly accepted. Donations should be delivered to Cross-Lines by November 25th, 2022. Re-opening the Kitchen Dining Area



Community Market Update

Grocery prices are skyrocketing. For the past months we have seen a dramatic increase in shoppers. With the pandemic and now inflation, many families and individuals are struggling to make ends meet. The more shoppers we have, the more volunteers we need to help make sure our shelves are always fully stocked. Here is some data we have from the last few months:

July- 874 families and 946 commodities totaling= 1,820 households August- 1,023 families and 1,056 commodities totaling= 2,079 households Sept- 1,274 families and 1,080 commodities totaling= 2,354 households


Households
