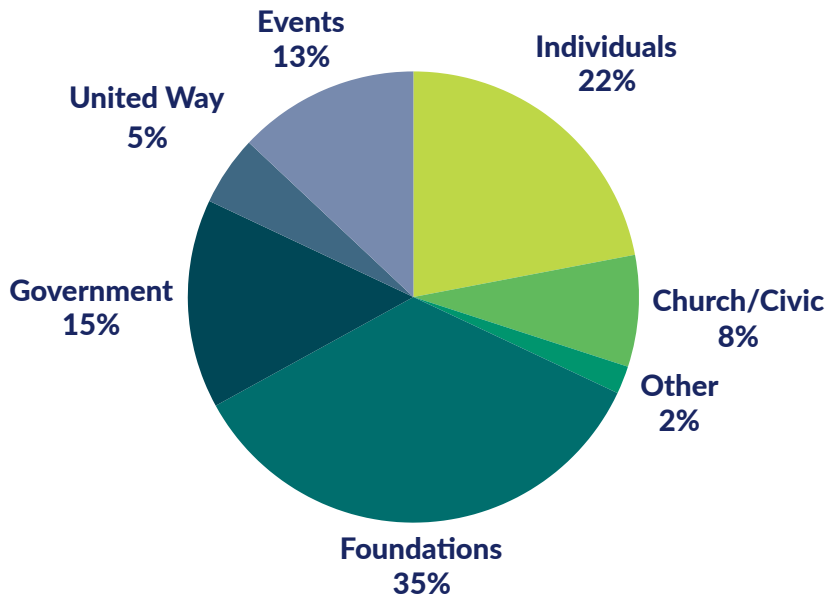


## **Beyond the tasks they perform, volunteers create a sense of community and connection that is vital to the work we do.**

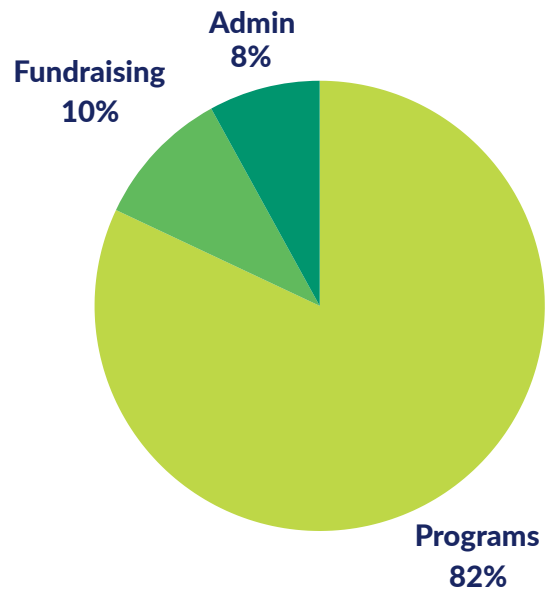
